



General Derby Rules & Regulations

1. Anyone under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs will not be permitted to drive and will lose their entree fee.
2. Cars must be derby ready for best dressed.
3. Intentional hit on driver's side door will result in an automatic Disqualification (judge's decision).
4. When a vehicle becomes disabled or timed out, drivers must break off their marker flag and remain in their vehicle until heat has ended.
5. Once the marker flag has been broken off a vehicle, it becomes untouchable! An intentional hit on an untouchable vehicle will result in disqualification (judge's decision).
6. **A Horn will indicate Start, Finish** and will also indicate an **Emergency**.
All vehicles must stop and or leave the track as directed by one of the judges or officials.
7. All cars have an assigned number, minimum size 12" x 12".
8. There is a 90 second rule in place. Driver's must start their stalled vehicles and make a hit within this time frame or you will be disqualified.
9. There will absolutely no stopwatches or headsets permitted in the car with the driver.
10. There is a second Fire Rule at the judge's discretion. If there is no potential driver hazard and such the driver will be able to continue, keeping in mind the 90-second rule. Once a second fire will occur, you will be disqualified.
11. If a vehicle has rolled-over, the driver may continue in the heat at the judge's discretion. The judges will look for potential driver's hazards such as a crushed roof, spillage of fuel, etc. Keep in mind the 90 seconds apply once the heat has started again.
12. Last aggressive hit will win the heat (judge's decision).
13. All vehicles must be inspected for safety, prior to the start of the derby. Absolutely No after factory reinforcements will be permitted. All cars winning their heat will be taken aside immediately after the heat and picked up and inspected for any reinforcing. If any found, the car is disqualified. The second place car will then move to the final.
Inspection will be done on site the day of the derby 7:00am – 11:30am
14. PIT BOSS AND/OR JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL.
15. The entry fee for all Powder-Puff drivers will be \$100.00, winner takes all plus trophy.
Drivers from main event are not allowed to drive in Powder-Puff
The entry fee for 4 + 6 cylinder will be \$200.00
The entry fee for V8 & Trucks will be \$250.00
16. All drivers must be 18 years of age and must have a legal current driver's license, Minors who are 15-17 years old are permitted to participate, but must have a parent or guardian's signature on a minor release form at the time of registration to participate.

*No substitution of drivers on registered cars.

If you are registered to a vehicle you are the only one allowed to drive in the main event.



Pit Rules

1. Minimum age of fourteen (14) years old during races.
2. No muscle shirts, sandals or shorts.
3. NO alcohol consumption or substance use prior or during races.
Anyone under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs will NOT be permitted to drive.
4. Absolutely NO GLASS beverage containers allowed in pit and camping area.
5. ZERO tolerance of inappropriate behavior and abusive language.
6. Pit area wristbands MUST be visible at all times on the wrist.
7. BOUNTY ENFORNCED: If a person is found NOT wearing a wristband, they will have to PURCHASE a wristband at the gate or WILL be escorted off the premises.
8. Dogs MUST be on a leash at all times.
9. Five (5) minutes after last feature race, pits WILL be opened to the public. Therefore, load your car immediately. NO race car engines will be permitted to start after the public is admitted.
10. Tech in is MANDATORY. Registration and waiver forms MUST be completed before tech.
11. Drivers and crew WILL be responsible for cleaning up spills and waste.
All spills MUST be reported immediately to an official.
12. MANIDTORY pre-race driver's meeting – ALL pit crew and drivers MUST attend.
Random roll calls will be made and if not in attendance – PENALITIES will be assessed.
13. Disputes WILL be cut off 15 minutes after results are posted, written disputes will be accepted for review. Dispute forms can be picked up from tech officials.
14. PAYOUT INFORMATION: Purse will be presented to the driver's in the lounge area WITHIN 1 hour of the last feature race/heat.
15. PIT BOSS AND/OR JUDGES DECISION WILL BE FINAL.
